

What is rude behavior?

Situation: Matt, Carol, and Mike are talking about the rude behavior of other people. Who is being rude? Listen to their conversation.

Matt: You know I take the bus, right? And every day, I sit in the back of the bus, alone, by myself. And I called you yesterday. Remember?

Carol: Yeah, I do the same thing. So, what's wrong? Why do you think people are impolite?

Matt: Well, two people kept giving me dirty look. They looked mad. And that's not the first time. Like, it's happened before. And when I got off the bus, one of them told me to stop using my cell! I don't' understand.

Mike: Oh, man, you know, the same thing happens to me all the time. Some people are really rude.

Carol: I know what you mean. Like, the other day, I was sitting in the park, smoking a cigarette. I was just sitting there, you know, enjoying the nice weather, looking at the birds, and smoking.

Mike: What happened?

Carol: When I finished my cigarette, I did what I always do when I smoke in the park. I put it on the sidewalk and crushed it with my shoe.

Mike: Yeah, that's what I do. That way it's not a danger anymore.

Carol: Well, this guy walking by saw me putting out my cigarette and told me that it was not very nice.

He said it was bad for the environment.

Matt: Why do people do such rude things?

Mike: You're so right, Matt. People are totally impolite.
