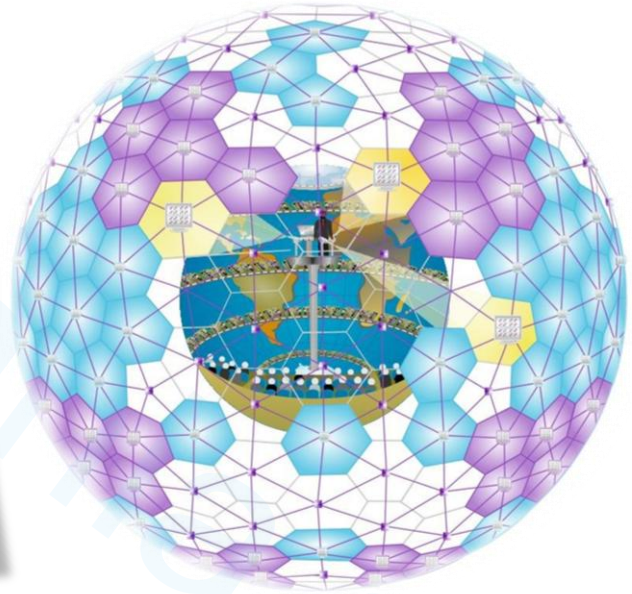

* FOR UNCERTAIN PREDICTION about the future, use may/might/could NOT can.

The letter (could/might) have gotten lost in the post.

We (could/might) have a party.

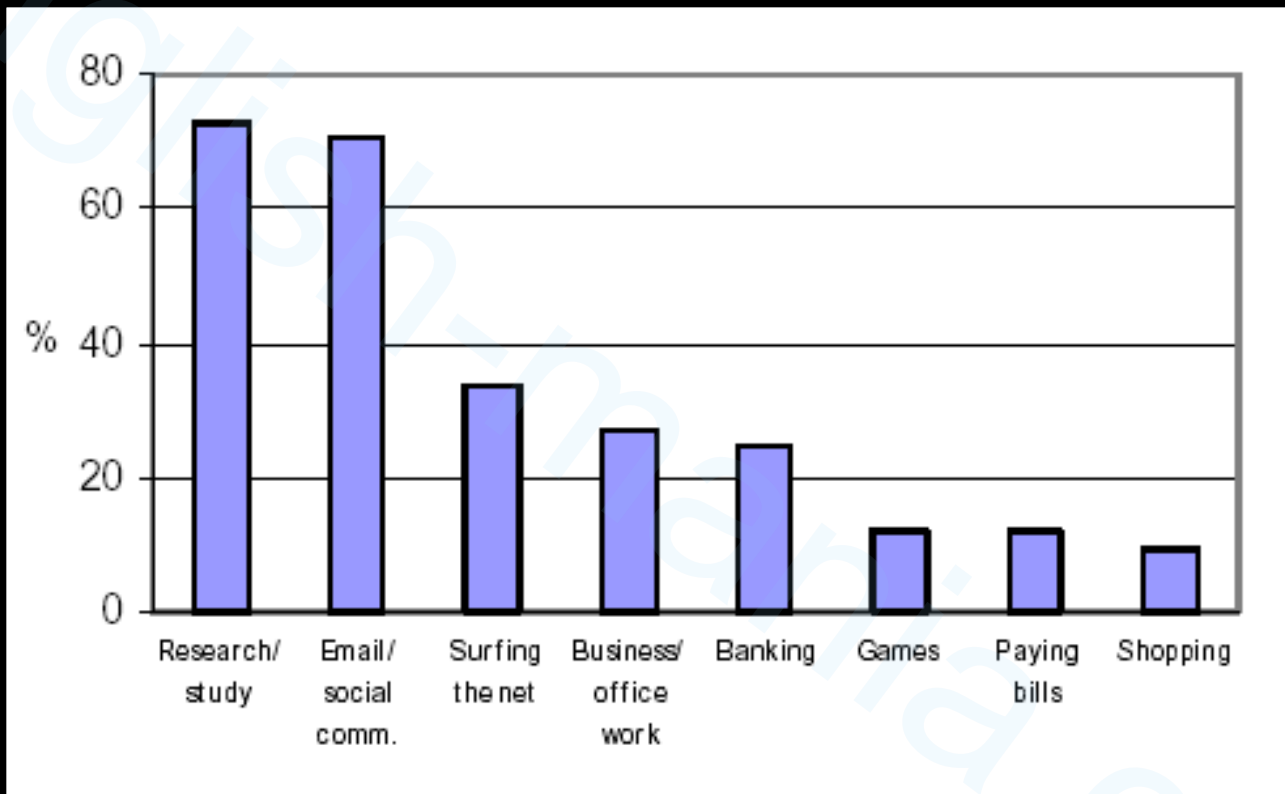
