

### Old People Living Alone




Would you allow your dad to live on his own when he's very old?

Think about Jane's situation to help you.






### Role play

I am your 65 year old mother/father. I want to live with you. How would you react? What would you tell me?








# When you become old, where would you prefer to live?

As you can see, my grandmother and grandfather is very special because..










### Two Minute Speech
