In conclusion, I think all families should accept each other's failures and help each other. This way, they can be close to being perfect.

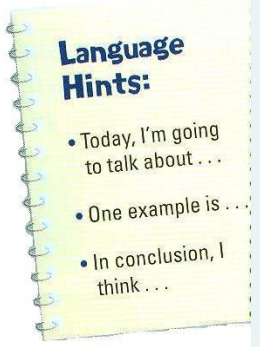
