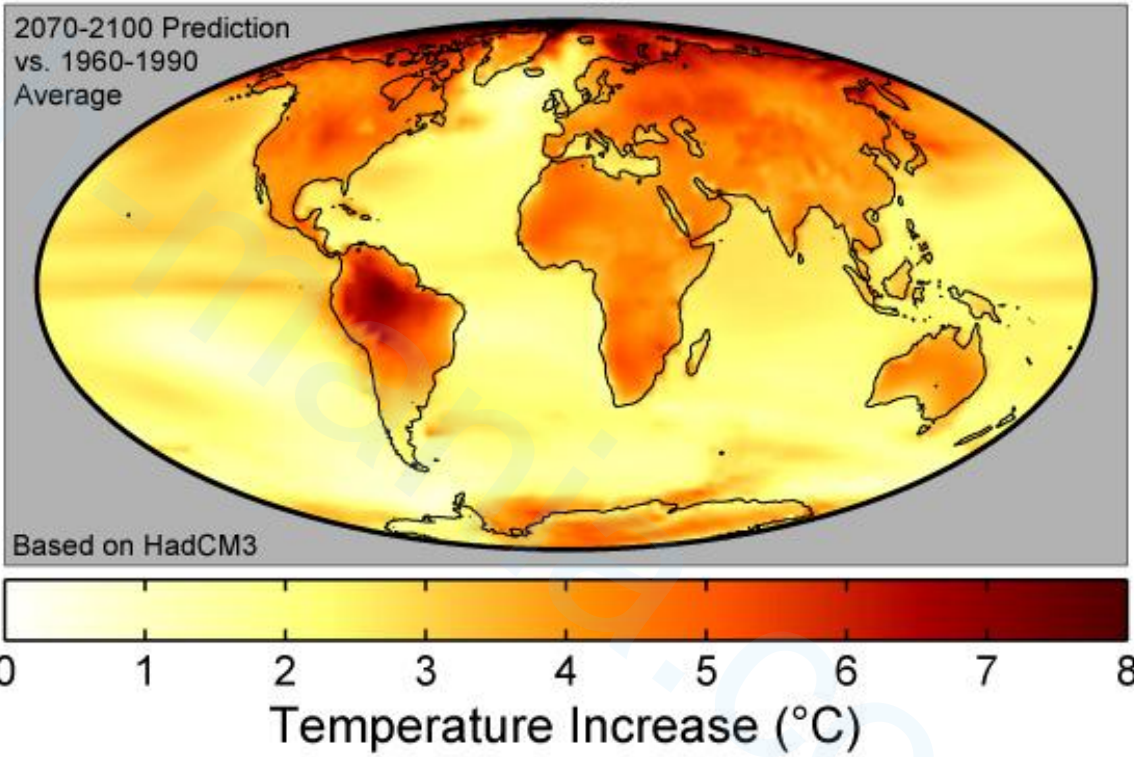

Global Warming Predictions





Dan: Did you change the air conditioning again?

So if we make the temperature of the AC a few degrees higher, we will save energy and help to save the Earth. Think about the future of our planet, Dan.

Dan: Well, I don't care about global warming. I don't care about saving energy. I like to be comfortable, Bob. One person cannot stop global warming. So, I will do what I want. And I want to be comfortable.

Bob: So you want to keep the apartment cold? You don't care about saving energy or about global warming?

Dan: You've got to chill out Bob. Don't worry about global warming. Scientists will find a solution. Now, please change the AC to 18.

Bob: If we set the AC back to 18. I **WILL** be chilled, Dan.

Dan: Great. Let's do it then.

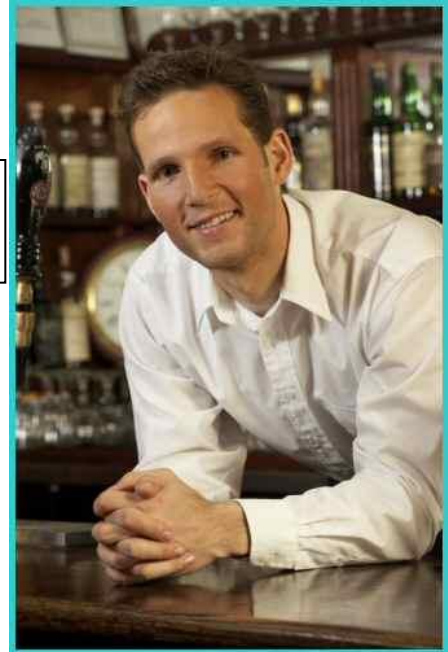
