B: All right. May I see your passport and flight ticket?

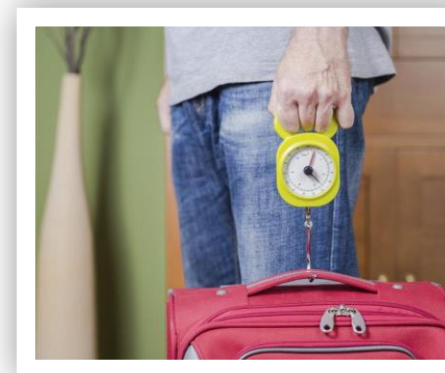
A: Here you are.

B: I'm sorry, but you need to lighten it. Or were going to charge a fee of 25 US dollars for this bag.

A: My luggage is giving me a lot of trouble!

A: Hi, I have one bag to put on board. But there's a problem.

B: All right, tell me about it while I weigh your bag.

A: There's a piece of pottery at the bottom. I wrapped it with air caps and newspaper, but I'm still worried.

B: Is it too big to carry on board? That would be safest.

A: I'm afraid so. Is there something that can be done?

B: We can have it marked 'fragile', but don't be too sure.

A: Well, that's good enough. It's not extremely valuable or anything.

A: No, I don't. There's an emergency back home and I didn't have time.

B: Well, where is your destination?

A: Seoul, Korea. At what time is the nearest flight?

B: There's one for two-thirty, leaving an hour from now. But it's been fully booked.

A: Are you sure? Are there no available seats at all?

B: I'll check one more time. Oh, someone cancelled their flight. There's one seat available in economy class.

A: I'll take that, please. Thank God.

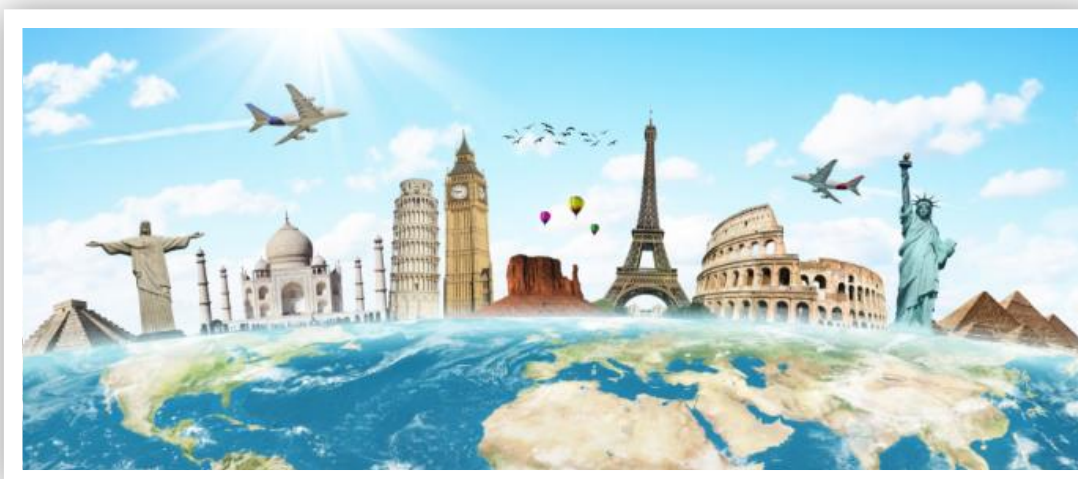
