Dialogue 1: Asking a passenger where to get off

A: Excuse me. Can I ask you something?

B: Sure, go ahead.

A: I am trying to get to City Hall. Am I on the right bus?

B: Yes. This bus goes to City Hall.

A: Then could you tell me how long it would take to get there?

B: It'll take about 10 minutes. I'll tell you when we get there.

A: Thank you. I'd really appreciate it.

B: Don't mention it. It's nothing really.



Dialogue 2: Asking for help when you've missed your stop

A: Excuse me. I think I missed my stop. Could you tell me where this is?

B: Well, the next stop is Hyde Park. You know where that is?

A: I don't know. I'm really new in the neighborhood.

B: OK then. Where were you going?

A: I was supposed to get off at Camden Town.

B: Camden Town? That's about 10 stops back! Boy, what happened?

A: I guess I dozed off. I'm in big trouble. What should I do?

B: Well, get off at the next stop. And take a ride back. And next time, Don't sleep.



Dialogue 3: Offering help to someone who seems lost

A: You seem lost. Do you need any help?

B: Thanks for asking. I'm not quite sure if I'm on the right bus.

A: Where are you headed?

B: I am trying to get to City Hall.

A: City Hall? You're on the right bus.

B: Is it far from here?

A: No. We're almost at City Hall. You'll have to get off at the next next stop.

B: Thanks a lot. If it weren't for you, I would have missed my stop.



Dialogue 4: Asking the bus driver where to get off

A: Excuse me. Does this bus go to City Hall?

B: Yes, you're on the right bus.

A: I'm not really sure when I should get off. Could you tell me when we get there?

B: I'm a bit busy here. Can't you see that I am driving?

A: I'm really sorry. But I would really appreciate some help.

B: I really can't help you. Go ask someone else.

A: Well, I guess I should.
