Dialogue 1: Deciding the place to play

A: Hello?

B: Good. Where do you want to play? At the university tennis court?

A: I don't think that's a good idea. It's too far away from my house.

B: Sure. Meet you there at two.



Dialogue 2: When the weather is bad

A: Hello?

B: Hello? May I speak to Jill?

A: This is she speaking.

B: Hi, Jill. This is Mary. Let's play tennis.

A: Now? It's pouring outside!

B: So? It's exciting to play in the rain.

A: Mary, let's just play tomorrow. I don't like this kind of weather.

B: Oh, all right. If you say so.



Dialogue 3: When your friend is not prepared

A: Hello?

B: Hi, Bob. It's me, Tony.

A: Hi, Tony.

B: It's about the tennis tournament that we entered. Let's practice tennis together.

A: Right now? Oh, I lost my racket yesterday.

B: Then let's go and buy it together. Then we can practice.

A: Good idea.
