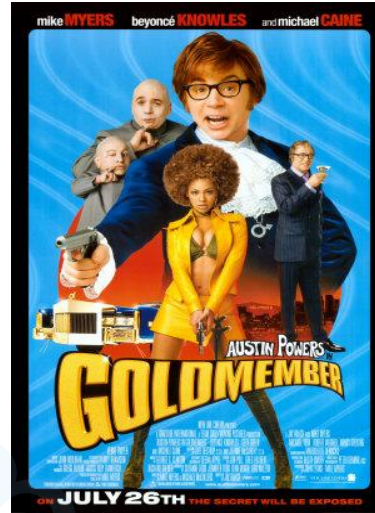
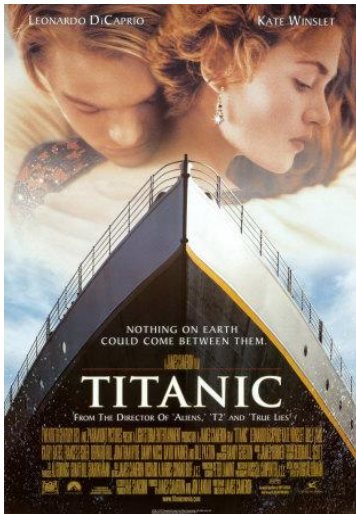

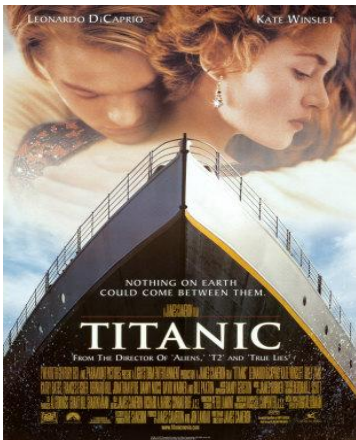


Dialogue 1:

A: Pirates of the Carribean.

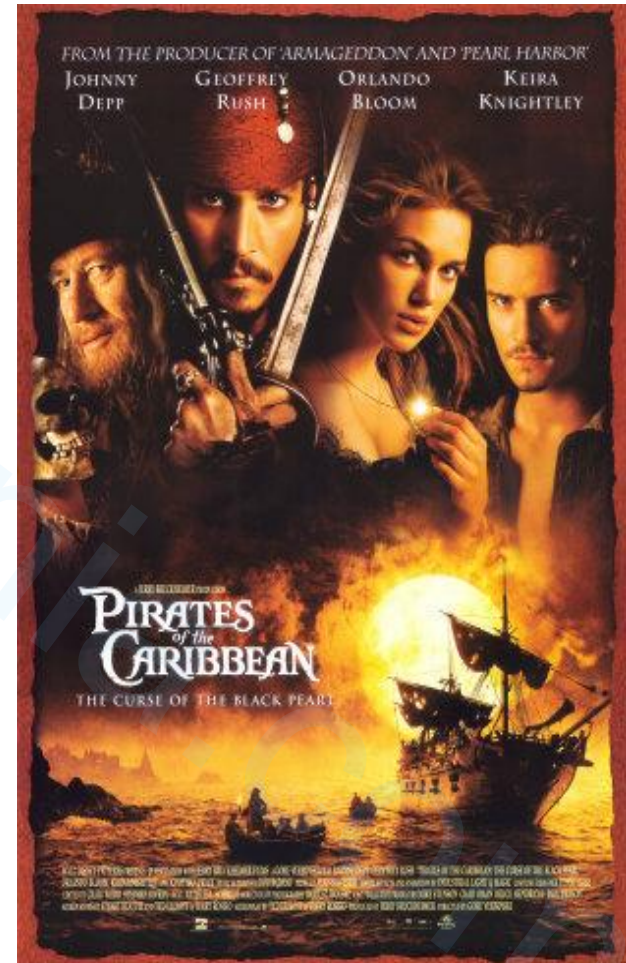
B: What's that again?

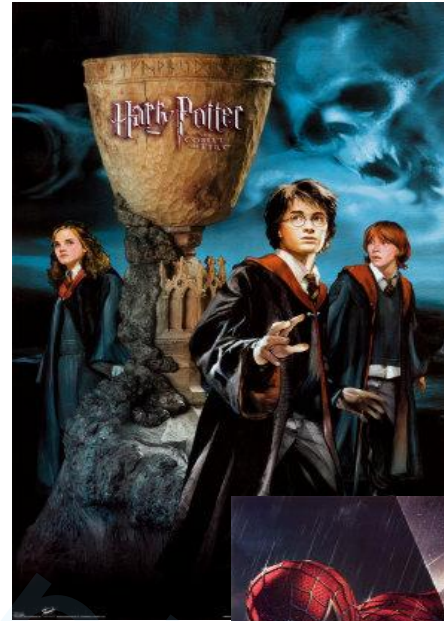
- A film that shows news events or social conditions
