#### 1 What is AmCham? AmCham (The American Chamber of Commerce) is a nonprofit association representing the interests of US investors in Singapore. It offers the opportunity to interact with over 1,300 key personnel from manufacturing to financial, business, and professional services. AmCham coordinates a regular program of events, including breakfasts, luncheons, and cocktail functions for members to hear prominent speakers, as well as seminars and panel discussions on subjects of particular interest.

2 Networking functions — social gatherings
There are many social events that the chamber offers to members.
Besides the unique networking opportunities, our social gatherings are held in the best venues in Singapore; recently, single nation business groups met at the Compass Rose restaurant on the 70th level of the Westin Stamford Hotel for the Financial Services Network Night.

### **3** Networking functions – seminars

Our evening seminars provide a relaxed, informative way to end the workday. The seminars cater to the personal development of our members rather than focusing on the business element. In addition to the seminars, we also arrange Network Nights with other chambers of commerce in Singapore. By doing so, we hope to strengthen ties between business leaders of different nationalities and between the different chambers.

#### 4 Who can join?

Our organization is open to companies and individuals of all nationalities. We do not cater only to American companies or individuals; in fact over 48% of our members are non-American, and Singaporeans account for just under 25% of our members. The diversity of our organization is well reflected by the diversity of our members. We have members from 42 different countries.
