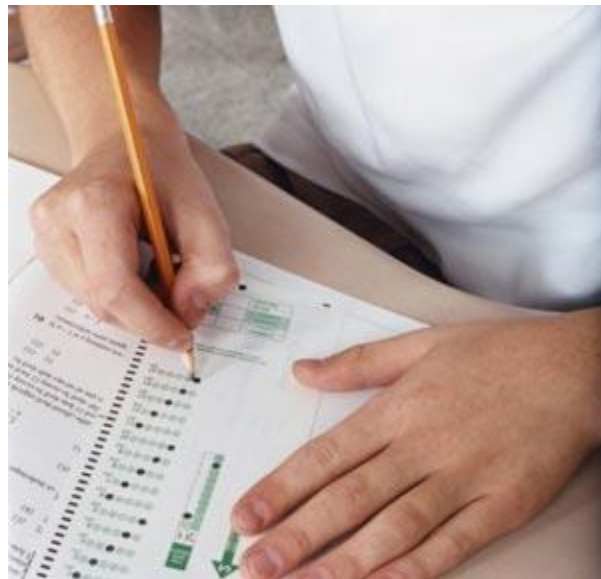
Dialogue
