Dialogue A

A: George, I want you to give me an annual sales report by next month.

B: I see. I can *hand it in* to you by next week.

A: Next week? **Can you handle it?**

B: No problem. Actually I am almost finished with the report.

Dialogue B

A: We need someone who can *back up* the marketing department.

B: I'm very much interested in marketing.

A: But, Matthew, you have to work more hours there. **Can you handle it?**

B: No problem.

Dialogue A

A: Mom, I want to go to a private institute.
I need to study more.

B: Susan, you already have private tutoring
every week. **Are you able to manage it?**

A: Yes. I can *manage the time* effectively.

Dialogue B

A: Saddle, I borrowed some money from the
bank.

B: Bill, then you have to pay the interest
every month. **Are you able to manage it?**

A: Yes. I have a part-time job.

B: Okay, but you should pay it back *as soon as
you can*.

Dialogue A

A: Joey, you *look very tired* these days.

B: Actually, I have six deadlines to meet by next week.

A: Really? **Can you get through it?**

B: I have no choice.

Dialogue B

A: Lisa, I heard that you are taking 4 courses this semester.

B: That's right.

A: **Can you get through it?**

B: Not really. I'm thinking of *dropping one course*.

Dialogue A

A: Ethan, I heard that you broke up with Joanne. **Do you think you can cope with it?**

B: Yeah, I'm pretty okay now.
Actually we dated only for a month.

A: *I am relieved* to hear that.

B: Thanks for your concern, Jonathan.

Dialogue B

A: I'm going to travel to Paris, Jane.

B: That sounds exciting. Do you speak French?

A: *Not at all.* I only speak English.

B: People say French people don't answer unless you speak French to them. **Do you think you can cope with it?**

A: Janet, *I got fired* from my job.

B: *How unfortunate!*

Are you able to deal with it?

A: I'm not sure, but I'm trying to *be positive*.

B: Billy, don't worry. It can only get better.

Dialogue B

A: John, I'm thinking of moving to a computer company.

B: Paul, *you've never worked in that area*. **Are you able to deal with it?**

A: Of course. I can learn fast.

B: Why don't you ask Teddy for help?
He worked in that area.


