B: What time do you close?

A: What time do you close?

B: We close at 7 p.m. on weekdays.

On weekends, we do not open.

A: Oh, I see.

B: I close at 4:30 p.m.

A: OK, see you then.

**Dialogue B**

A: Hello, I'd like to change Russian ruble into U.S. dollars.

What time do you stay open till?

B: We are available until 9 p.m. at the airport.

A: I'd like to renew my driver's license.  
What do I need?

B: You need two portrait shots and  
an application form filled out.

A: Okay. How late do you stay open?

B: Until 5 p.m.

**Dialogue B**

A: Hello? Vicky's store. How may I help you?

B: Hi. I bought a dress the other day,  
but I want to exchange it for another one.  
How late do you stay open?

A: We are open till 8 p.m.

Just stop by any time it's convenient for you.

A: At 6 p.m. So shall we meet at the cinema at 6:30?

B: All right. See you then.

B: Oh, hello there!

A: I got your invitation and I'll be there.

B: Oh, good. So you can come?

When do you finish your work?


