Dialogue A

Dialogue B

Dialogue A

A: What is your occupation?

B: I'm a government employee.

A: Really? How long have you worked for the government?

B: About ten years.

Dialogue B

A: It's not easy to survive in a recession like this.

B: What is your occupation?

A: I'm a taxi driver.

B: I know what you mean.

I rarely take a taxi these days.

Dialogue A

A: What do you do for a living?

B: I'm a doctor.

A: What's your specialty?

A: I'm a pediatrician.

Dialogue B

A: What do you do for a living?

B: Actually, I lost my job last month because of my company's personnel reduction.

A: I'm sorry to hear that.

B: That's okay. I will get a new job soon.



Notes:

Dialogue A

A: Are you a soldier?

B: No. Why did you think so?

A: I thought you are a soldier from your haircut.

If you are not a soldier, what do you do?

B: I'm a computer programmer.

Dialogue B

A: What do you do?

B: I'm on active service in the Navy.

A: Are you *a professional soldier*?

B: No. It's obligatory to perform military duties

in our country, and I'm in the navy for it.

A: What kind of work are you in?

B: I run a small business.

A: Sounds great.

B: It may seem so, but it is not easy to operate a small enterprise in our country.

Dialogue B

A: What kind of work are you in?

B: I'm working for a stock company.

A: Then you must be an expert in making money in the stock market.

B: Not at all. Actually, I'm a secretary.
