A: Oh, really? I wish I were.

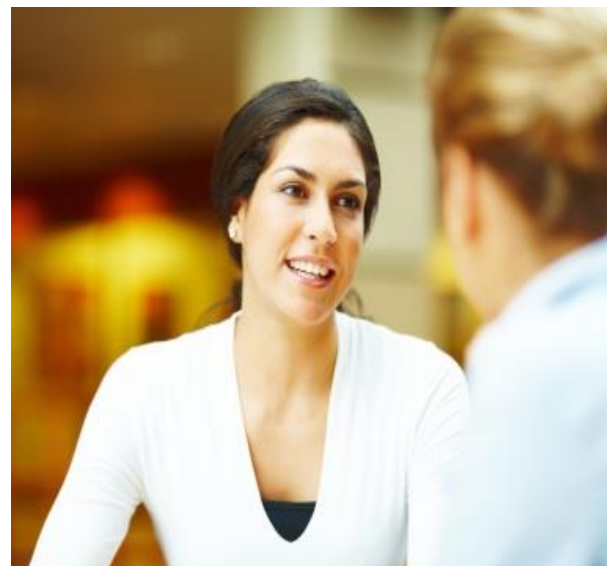
Dialogue B
