Dialogue A

A: Is it correct to say rc?

B: Do you mean for the television?

It's the remote control.

A: Really? I didn't know that.

Dialogue B

A: Mr. Smith, is it correct to say culture inheritance?

B: Well, inheritance often means money or property. In that case, cultural heritage is correct.

A: Oh, I see.



Notes:

Dialogue A

A: James, can I say hand-phone instead of cell-phone?

B: No. Native speakers of English can not understand that word. You should use cell-phone or cell.

A: Oh, I see. Thank you very much.

Dialogue B

A: Can I ask you a question?

B: Yes.

A: Can I say arbeit?

B: No. We use part-time job for that meaning in English.



Notes:

Dialogue A

A: Which is correct, I have one sister or I have a one sister?

B: I have one sister and I have a sister are fine, but I have a one sister sounds pretty strange.

A: Thank you.

Dialogue B

A: Peter, do you know which is correct, backpack travel or backpacking?

B: Backpacking is right.

A: Oh, yes. It's always confusing.



Notes:

Dialogue A

A: Is it proper to say lover instead of boyfriend?

B: We usually say boyfriend.

A: It's the first time I've heard that.

Dialogue B

A: Sometimes I don't know how to express myself in English.

B: If you have any questions concerning English, feel free to ask me.

A: Now that you mention it, is it proper to say overeat?

B: No. It's not correct. You should say throw up in that case.

Dialogue A

A: Is it accurate to say perma?

B: No, it isn't. You should say perm or permanent when you do your hair.

A: Oh, I see. Thank you.

B: Any time.

Dialogue B

A: Peter, I have a question.

B: Yes. What is it?

A: Is it accurate to say aircon instead of air conditioner?

B: Oh, you should say air conditioner.
