Clouds

Before Reading

- ★ Do you see clouds in the sky today?
- ★ What are the colors of clouds?

A cloud is a **mass** of **droplets** in the sky. When the sun heats up the Earth, water on the Earth **evaporates** and becomes a cloud. What happens if a cloud gets big and **thick**? It rains. Thick clouds are darker than **thin** clouds. So the sky looks gray right before it rains. Can we **grab** a cloud? No, we can't. A cloud **consists** of water droplets, so we cannot grab a cloud at all. When you touch it, all you can get are **wet** hands!

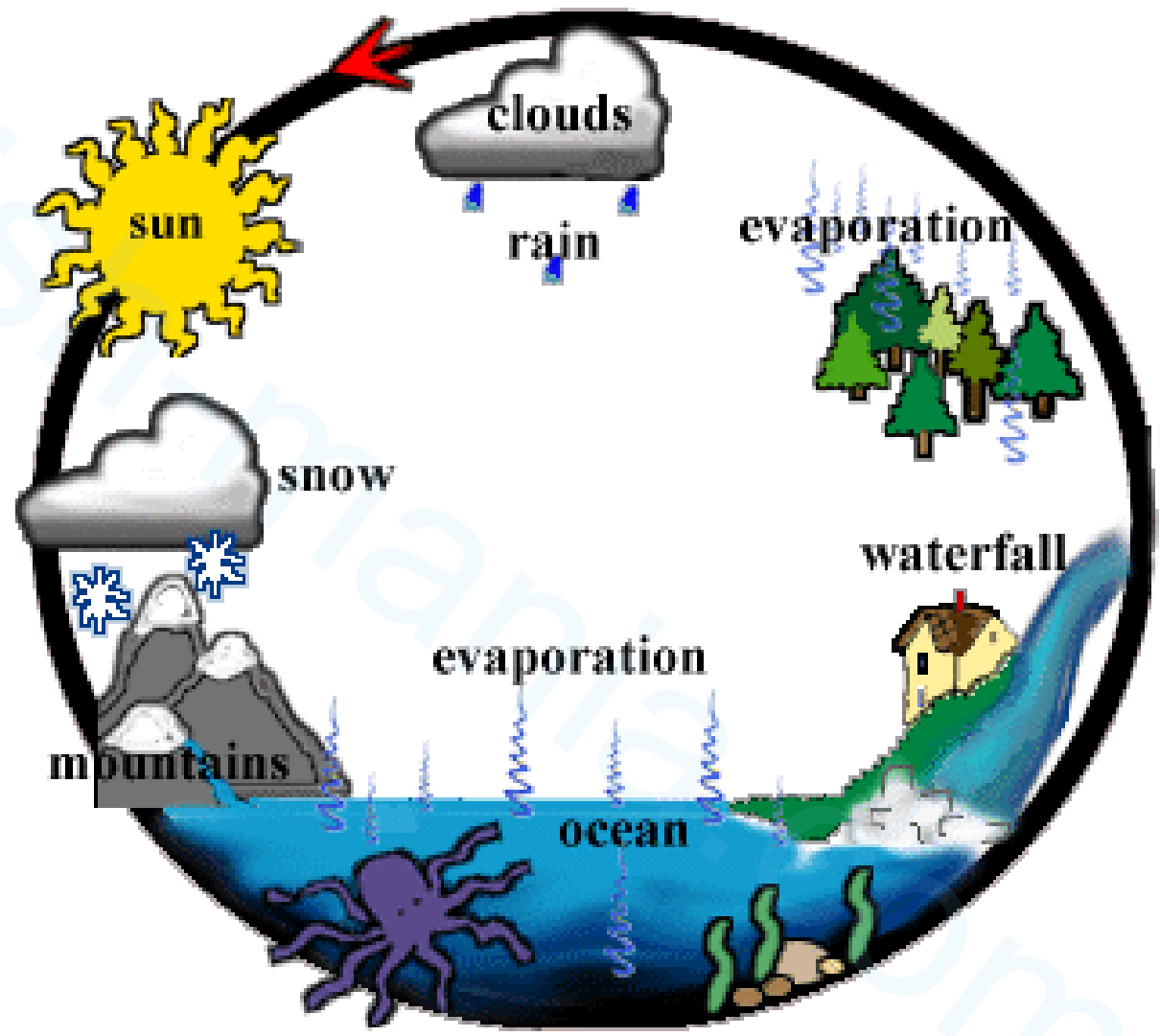
